General Description of Concerts: Experienced chamber music players who have a group together have the opportunity to perform at Kirribilli. These concerts are held several times a year at the Kirribilli Neighbourhood Centre (KNC), commencing 5pm on the first Sunday afternoon of the month. They are variously referred to as Kirribilli Concerts and as Sunset Concerts.

Travel

Car: parking may be difficult and time should be allowed to walk from the car to the KNC.

Rail: KNC is a 5-minute stroll from Milsons Point Railway Station; there is a frequent rail service from Town Hall, and a 15-minute service from the North Shore.

Ferry: Milsons Point Wharf is a short walk under Sydney Harbour Bridge to the KNC. There is a ferry every half hour which takes five minutes from Circular Quay and nine minutes from Balmain.

Venue: The Kirribilli Neighbourhood Centre (KNC) is a heritage-listed sandstone building at 16-18 Fitzroy St, Kirribilli near the intersection with Jeffrey St.
